**Contractor's Project Coordinator/Administrator Qualifications**

In addition to the requirements of Section 105 06 of the Cuyahoga County Engineer's General Contract Provisions, the Contractor shall note the following:

Due to the complexity of this project and the specialized nature of the construction activities and coordination requirements, the Contractor shall employ a qualified full-time field Project Coordinator/Administrator demonstrating documented experience in the following areas:

- Relevant experience in the construction of a minimum of two (2) movable bridge projects, including at least one (1) completed vertical lift bridge project, within the last ten (10) years.
- Employment as a Project Coordinator/Administrator for the Prime Contractor on at least one (1) successfully completed movable bridge project within the last ten (10) years.
- Thorough knowledge in structural steel erection, truss bridge fabrication, movable bridge operating machinery, movable bridge electrical work, and movable bridge controls
- Experience with other types of complex bridge construction projects of similar scope and magnitude
- Experience in working over, within and adjacent to navigable waterways under the jurisdiction of the U.S. Coast Guard and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers
- Experience with float-in/float-out construction methods on active navigable waterways
- Thorough knowledge of all permitting requirements
- Experience with dealing with local, state and federal agencies

The Contractor shall submit documentation demonstrating the Project Coordinator/Administrator's relevant experience to the County within seven (7) calendar days following contract award. The Project Coordinator/Administrator's qualifications will be reviewed by the Engineer for conformance with the requirements outlined above. In the event that the Contractor wishes to appoint a different Project Coordinator/Administrator at any time during the contract, the Contractor shall immediately notify the Engineer and submit documentation of the replacement Project Coordinator/Administrator's qualifications to the Engineer for acceptance by the County
