- Any costs not specified in the vendors quote will not be considered
- The Cuyahoga County Code requires all Contractors doing more than \$10,000.00 in business annually with the County to register with the Cuyahoga County Agency of Inspector General. Registration consists of completing an online form, signing an online Ethics Certification form, completing an online 30-minute ethics video training and payment of a \$100.00 registration fee.

Please visit the link below to review information about the process and complete registration. Anyone in the company can do the video ethics training and the registration is good for 4 years. For "**Emergency and Unforeseen Time**

Sensitive Mission Critical Purchases" registration is required within 30 days of the purchase.
